Main versions

We should always prioritise the use of the Main Logo version. The correct use of derivative versions is normally limited by the dimensions of the formats in their digital or printed VERSIONS.

These versions are secondary and cannot be altered.





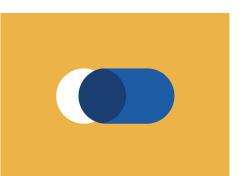

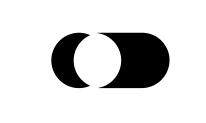

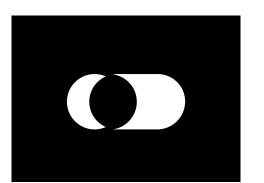

Colours

Primary colours

RESIST Blue 1 is the main colour of the RESIST identity so it has the strongest presence on our brand.

RESIST Blue 2 balances the other colours and gives space to the elements.

RESIST Yellow complements the Blue colours, creating balance and making the palette more distinctive and warmth.

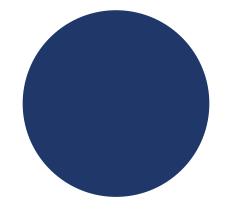
Secondary colours

These colours provide flexibility when you need to present a large variety of elements. They should be used to accent the primary palette, never dominate the piece.

Deep Blue(*) is assigned to the usage of text.

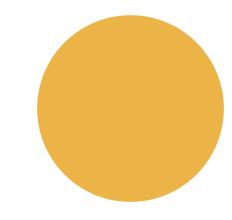
Light Ivory (**) contrasts the cool corporate colours and its Its use is specific for backgrounds.

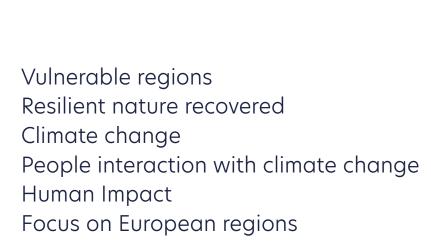
The dotted pattern background works as a core graphical element in RESIST communication materials.

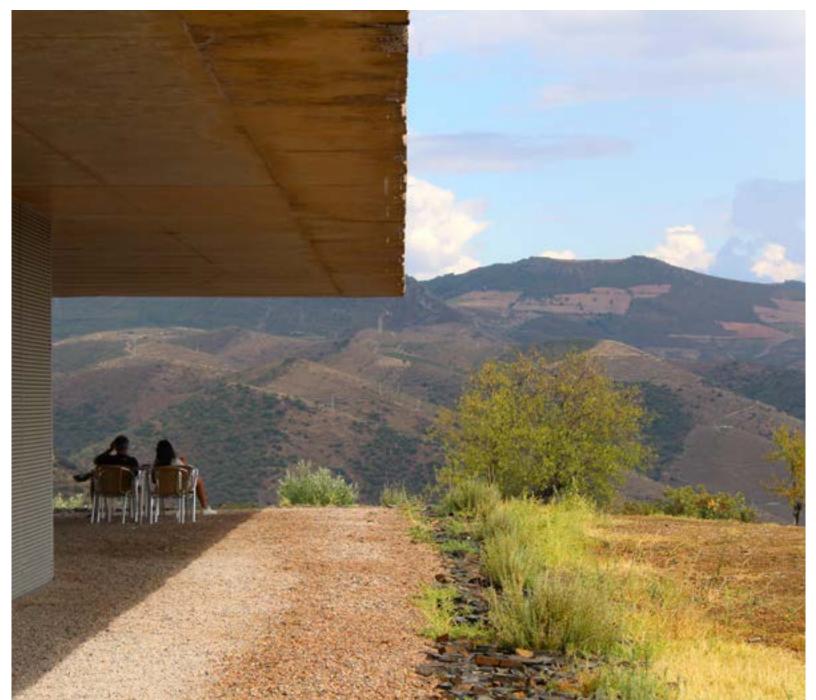
The dots stand for the exchange of ideas and the great achievements and results when people work together.

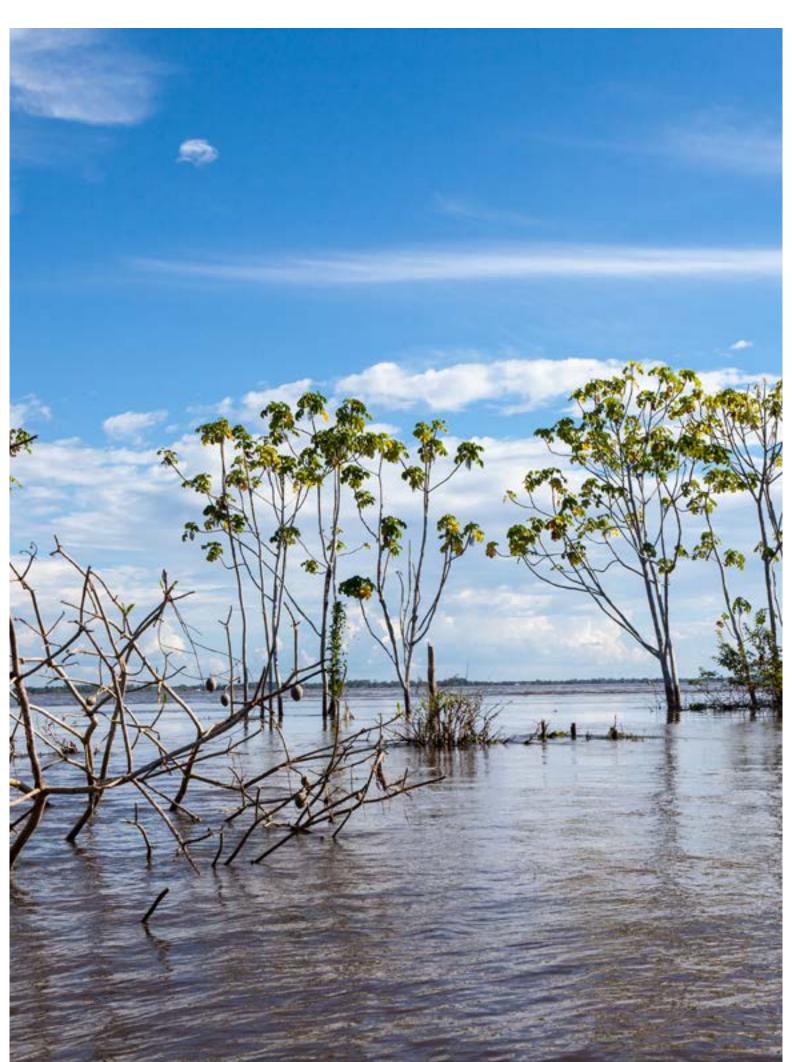

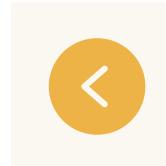

- . Always scaled proportionaly using the grid as reference.



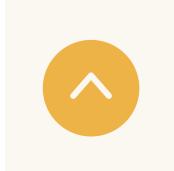
























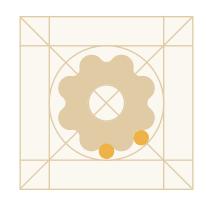

Tables

Tables allow the reader to find the logically organized information allowing to locate specific data in different series.

To create a table for RESIST you must:

- use titles as short as possible
- organize data logically
- highlight totals or important data
- minimize visual elements
- you must not use shadows, borders or any type of effect.

Charts and tables should be designed to communicate in a visual style that is simple and clean, minimizing the number of colors used to best convey an idea. Colors used should always draw from the brand palette. Numerals should be set in Neusa Condensed Light.
